


NSW Government Fleet

NSW Government Fleet Model Key Outcomes



\$250m Funding Outsourced

- Funding managed through the RFQ bidding process
- Average \$200 per month per vehicle reduction



Consolidated Planning

- Modulated lease periods for agencies
- Consolidated fleet planning
- Inclusion of heavy commercial fleet
- Profit share program



Improved Supplier Satisfaction

- Fortnightly bidding cycle
- Averaging 500 vehicles per month
- Proactive engagement: tailored solutions / process mapping

NSW Government Fleet Model Key Outcomes



Centralised data capture

- Identification of NSWG core spend and model performance metrics
- Portfolio analytics
- Reporting transparency and sharing of data across NSWG
- Cluster benefits reporting scorecards from competitive supply




Innovation: transforming the way government operates

The Changing Fleet Landscape

Mobility solutions to positively impact Total Cost of Ownership (TCO) and reduce environmental impact

Vehicle manufacturers driving technological progress

- Autonomous vehicles
- Telematics devices
- 'Smartphones on Wheels'

Shift in Agency policy development

'Car-Centric' to 'People-Centric'

NSW Pre-Qualification Scheme (SCM0653)

Scheme Overview

- Twice a year manufacturer tender
- Approved Vehicle List (AVL) published on NSWBuy

Rationalising the AVL

- Scaled down from >700 vehicle models to <250
- Reflects best value fit-for-purpose
- reflects the public perception

Benefit

 14%-18% reduction compared to government published discounts on some vehicles

NSW Department of Industry - Telematics

Challenge/Solution

- Reduce motor vehicle accidents and net costs
- Install telematics in 76 vehicles under 6-month trial

Outcomes/Benefits

- One reported accident during the trial
- Reduction in cost of claims; 74% improvement
- Reduction in private use for Fringe Benefit Tax
- Reduction in worker's compensation costs
- Improved fleet optimisation to 'de-fleet' by 30 June 2018
- Replaced manual log sheets with electronic log sheets.



NSW Shared Mobility Trial

Challenge

Investigate improvement opportunities for general purpose pool vehicles

Trial Objectives

- Examine the benefits of using in-car technology solution
- Understand the benefits of sharing across Clusters
- Feasibility of partially replacing general purpose pools with car-sharing services

The trial is expected to deliver outcomes in late 2018

Future Consideration: Hybrid / Electric Vehicles

Current Fleet Mix

Toyota Camry Altise & Toyota Corolla Hybrid in the fleet

Challenges

- Purchase prices
- Limited model range in market
- Charging infrastructure

Future Strategy

Proactively explore future opportunities as part of the fleet mix
